



SIMPLE FAMILY GAMES

Famous Person Game: Each family member puts a post it note on their forehead with a name of a famous person. During dinner, each person asks yes or no questions for others to answer, then tries to guess what famous person they have been assigned.

Group Draw: Everyone starts with a piece of paper and has 30 seconds to draw on it. Then, pass! The papers move to the right. And, another 30 seconds to draw on that paper. Play continues drawing and adding to each paper before passing after 30 seconds of drawing. Each family member adds his/her style to the drawings. Drawings are shared after passed around the table at least two times.

1,2,3 look! Player sit at the dinner table and look down. To begin, one person calls out "1,2,3, look!". Then, all players look up and focus on one person. If two people are looking at each other, they are "out". The winner is anyone that is looking at someone and not having them look back in return. There can be multiple winners. Play continues with players looking down and one saying, "1,2,3, look!" Points can be tallied for wins or play can be just for fun and giggles!
